To obtain critical weather information, NOAA's National Weather Service (NWS), part of the U.S. Department of Commerce, established SKYWARN® with partner organizations. SKYWARN® is a volunteer program with between 350,000 and 400,000 trained severe weather spotters

SKYWARN Training Classes lead by a NWS Staff Meteorologist include information on: Basics of thunderstorm development, fundamentals of storm structure, identifying potential severe weather features, information to what conditions to report, how and to whom to report your information as well as basic severe weather safety.
